



## List of Hazardous Items and Substances Prohibited by Transportation for Air























## Items and Substances Prohibited for Carriage in Baggage





Crossbows, guns, cavalry swords, sabers, cavalry sabers, yatagans, broadswords, swords, court swords, bayonets, daggers, knives: hunting knives, ballistic knives, pocket knives and any items that imitate weapons, swords, court swords, bayonets, daggers, and any simulated weapon items.



Household knives (scissors), with a blade length of more than 6 cm.



Alcoholic beverages with an alcohol content of 24 - 70% by volume in containers not exceeding 5 I, in retail packaging, limited to 5 I per person.



Aerosol dispensers for sports or household needs, covered with a protective cap against spontaneous activation of the dispenser, in containers not exceeding 0.5 kg or 0.5 limited to 2 kg or 2 l per person.



Small arms and ammunition securely packaged (subclass 1.4S, UN 0012 or UN 0014 only) are not allowed in the cabin of the aircraft and are transported in their original cases or containers in places isolated from passengers and crew members in the cargo compartments of the aircraft. ## Items Allowed On-Board In Hand Luggage





Medical or clinical thermometer - 1 ea. per person in a protective case.



Mercury thermometer or barometer, packed in an air-tight container and sealed with the seal of the sender.



Safety matches (one small package) or a small cigarette lighter - 1 ea. per person (WITH YOU)



Dry ice for cooling perishable products - no more than 2.5 kg



Non-hazardous liquids, gels and aerosols: in containers with a capacity of not more than 100 ml (or an equivalent capacity in other volume units), packed in a securely closed transparent plastic bag with a volume of not more than 1 liter - one bag per passenger.



Alcoholic beverages purchased in Duty Free shops and packed in a special sealed bag



Liquids in containers with a capacity of more than 100 ml will not be accepted for carriage even if the container is only partially filled. An exception for transportation is medicines and baby food



Lithium-ion batteries. Please check the rules and restrictions of transportation with the airline company staff.
